Voice: Perform from memory two contrasting solos of art music such as those required for solo festival or for All-State Chorus auditions. Keyboard accompaniments are required. You may bring your own accompanist, or you may request a UWG pianist.

Winds: Perform a published solo or etude such as those required for solo festival. Accompaniments are not required. *

Percussion: Perform a published solo or etude for snare drum, timpani, and keyboard percussion.

Guitar: Perform a published solo or etude written or transcribed for classical guitar. *

Directions to UWG

From Atlanta:

Take I-20 West to Villa Rica/West Georgia exit 24, turn left (south) onto Hwy. 61. Travel approximately 12 miles to Carrollton West Bypass, Hwy. 166; turn left onto bypass. At the sixth traffic light (at CVS Pharmacy), turn right onto Maple Street. UWG will be approximately .6 of a mile on left. Turn left at the east entrance (by McDonald's) and cross three raised cross walks/speed bumps. Kathy Cashen Recital Hall is housed in the Humanities Building located on the left. The Townsend Center for the Performing Arts is on the right.

From Rome:

Take Hwy 27 South and turn right onto Maple Street. Turn right onto campus at the third traffic light (by McDonald's) and cross three raised cross walks/speed bumps. Kathy Cashen Recital Hall is housed in the Humanities Building located on the left. The Townsend Center for the Performing Arts is on the right.

From Columbus:

Take I-185 North to Newnan, take Hwy. Alt 27/Hwy. 16 North to Carrollton, turn left onto south Bypass, Hwy. 166. At the fourth traffic light (at CVS Pharmacy), turn right onto Maple Street. UWG will be approximately .6 of a mile on left. Turn left at the east entrance (by McDonald's) and cross three raised cross walks/speed bumps. Kathy Cashen Recital Hall is housed in the Humanities Building located on the left. The Townsend Center for the Performing Arts is on the right.

From Birmingham:

Take I-20 East to Bremen/West Georgia exit 11, turn right (south) and follow Hwy. 27, south to Carrollton. Turn right onto campus at the third traffic light (by McDonalds) and cross three raised cross walks/speed bumps. Kathy Cashen Recital Hall is housed in the Humanities Building located on the left. The Townsend Center for the Performing Arts is on the right.
